Procedure #43Temporary Release of Equipment from Facility Building

Use of Equipment external to the Facility Building may become necessary temporarily during decommissioning activities performed by personnel or contract personnel. The following survey program shall control transfer to the exterior of the building.

- I. Forklift surveys shall consist of (5) smears taken on wheel surfaces & horizontal surfaces to assess removable contamination.
  - A.) The Forklift shall be positioned on clean paper directly in front of the truck bay door prior to exiting the building. At that location the smears will be taken & assessed prior to moving forklift outside.
  - B.) The criteria for temporary release shall be less than 500 dpm/100 cm<sup>2</sup>.
  - C.) Values in excess of this level shall require remedial action outlined in Procedure #28 Amended Section (D.2).
  - D.) Personnel operating the forklift will not dismount from the forklift while it is external of the building.
- II. Other equipment or materials shall be surveyed as above with the following exceptions.
  - A.) Value for release shall be less than 1000 dpm/100 cm<sup>2</sup>.
  - B.) Equipment may be removed via the Change Area or the West Door Exit.

All Equipment released from the building will be under the controlled supervision of INI personnel or Contract personnel & will be remanded to the building at the conclusion of utilization.


