Dear Chairman Hendrie,

Tomorrow morning fourteen Mpls. citizens and I are leaving for Harrisburg to join the United Mine Workers, International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, the International Chemical Workers, Graphic Arts International, United Auto Workers, the International Longshoremen's and Warehousemen's Union, United Furniture Workers of America, the International Woodworkers of America, along with the people of Pennsylvania and other states to demand that Two Mile Island Unit One be kept closed on the two year anniversary of the March 28 nuclear accident, and that Unit 2 be kept shut down and that radioactive water not be dumped in the Susquehanna River.

What happened at TMI haunts the American people, and we appeal to you to resolve this matter in the most healthful way possible.
