Dear Mr. John Ahearne:

We are appalled that the president of the General Public Utilities has asked the NRC to allow reopening procedures on unit one of the three mile island nuclear power plant before hearings are even completed. In most situations, this would be considered a selfish request of an executive asking a government agency to break the law at the expense of the public's health and welfare. Unfortunately, the NRC has done this before, when the venting of krypton gas was allowed without a public hearing, which is required by law.

We would also like to state our disapproval of the requested dumping of 700,000 gallons of radioactive water into the Sasquehann River. The expense of proper disposal should not take priority over public health and welfare.
