Dear Major Meine:

Enclosed you will find the licensee's copy of Form AEC-591 titled "Inspection Findings and Licensee Acknowledgment." This form shows that no item of noncompliance was found during the inspection conducted on August 5, 1964 at the USARAL-RMDT. No signature or acknowledgment on the part of the licensee is required.

I wish to call to your attention, as well as Captain Tengler's, license Condition 4 D., Labeling, which specifies the labeling which shall appear on each outside container transported to or from Fort Richardson, Alaska under the terms and conditions of this license. I mention this because of the discussions which related to devices and special equipment containing radioactive materials possessed by USARAL under licenses issued to the Department of the Army by the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission. Although the records maintained by the RMDT record the items by name, model and serial numbers, the actual radioactive isotope and quantities are not normally identified in the records. In order to insure uniformity between all waste disposal licensees your records should record the disposal of such materials by identifying the isotope contained and the quantity of material contained in units of microcuries or millicuries.

Please convey my respects to Colonel Wylie. I want to thank you, Major Drury, Captain Tengler and Captain Soyster for your assistance and cooperation during the inspection.
