Gentlemen:

This is in response to your recent letter requesting DA Labels 15 and DA Labels 51. It appears that these labels are Department of the Army Forms, and must be ordered by you through regular Army channels. I telephoned the 6th Army Chemical Officer at the Presidio in San Francisco. They suggested I refer you to Department of the Army Pamphlet 310-2 for ordering information. They said these labels were normally ordered through the local publications or forms office. They also stated that the labels would certainly be in stock at Fort Richardson, Fort Wainwright, or Fort Greely.

This office cannot supply labels in large quantities. We do maintain a small supply of various types of labels, mainly as samples and for the incidental labelling which we ourselves might do. We do not have the DA labels which you need. However, I am enclosing a few of two types of labels which seem to come close to what you need. These may tide you over until you are able to replenish your supply through your regular channels.
