Gentlemen:

This letter relates to the discussions Mr. Johnson of this office held with Colonel Hunt, Lt. Col. Owen Osburn, Capt. John Tongler, and others of your staff at the conclusion of the recent inspection of AEC License No. 20-10023-1. In particular, as a result of this inspection, certain of your licensed activities appear to be in noncompliance with AEC requirements. The items and references to the pertinent requirements are listed in paragraph 3 on Form AEC-592, enclosed.

The purpose of this letter is to give you an opportunity to advise us in writing of (a) your position concerning these items, (b) any corrective steps you may have taken or plan to take with respect to each item listed on the attached form, and (c) the date all corrective action was or will be completed.

Your reply should be sent to us within 30 days of the date of this letter to assure that it will receive proper attention in our further evaluation of the matter.
