Certain activities under your license appear to be in violation of AEC requirements. These apparent violations are considered to be of Category II severity:

1. License Condition 19 requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with statements, representations and procedures contained in your application dated April 9, 1974. An attachment to this application is a procedure entitled, "Regulations for the Use of Radionuclides at Harvard University."
 - a. Contrary to the requirements of your procedures, (Item 6(d) and 6(f), page 6) authorized investigators failed, in certain cases, to maintain all of the required records.
 - b. Contrary to the requirements of your procedure (Item 10(a), page 9) a container of I-125 contaminated waste was not sealed to prevent release of airborne activity.
