1. Reference letter, USAEC, Division of Compliance, Region V, 17 September 1965, to CG, US Army, Alaska, with 1 inclosure, Form AEC-592.

2. The information contained herein is in response to paragraph 2 of reference 1. The two matters discussed are those reported in paragraphs 5(a) and 5(b) of Form AEC-592, forwarded as inclosure to reference.

a. The use of the terms "chemical waste not otherwise specified" has been discontinued, effective 20 September 1965. The last shipment so marked was received by the USARAL RMDF on 20 September 1965. All future incoming and outgoing shipments will be labeled to identify the principle radioisotope, mixed fission products, or mixed activation products, as appropriate. In addition, the label on each container will include the radiation level at the container surface and at one meter from the container.

b. In the past, the following records of receipt for radioactive material have been maintained: Stock Accounting Record (DA Form 1296) and Register of Vouchers to Stock Record Account (DA Form 272). DA Form 1296 lists gains, losses, and balance on hand for each type item. DA Form 272 is the register of vouchers

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
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covering all incoming and outgoing shipments. Effective immediately, the attached form (DA Form 2502-R) will be prepared to accompany each incoming and outgoing shipment. The information contained on this form, along with the two forms previously described, will provide a complete detailed history of all transactions by the RMDF.
