Gentlemen:

Enclosed in Amendment No. 27 which renews your NRC License Number 34-06002-01 in its entirety. Please be advised of the following:

1. Since you do not have an authorized user who meets the training criteria specified for Groups IV and V, we have not authorized you to possess these Groups in their entirety. However, we have authorized your possession and use of iodine-131 and storage of phosphorus-32 (soluble). If you wish to pursue your initial request to possess Groups IV and V, you will need to submit documentation for a physician who has received training in accordance with Appendix A, Item 4 of Regulatory Guide 10.8, October 1980 (enclosed).
2. In order to authorize your possession and use of the cesium-137 calibration source, you will need to re-check the model number of the calibrator and submit. Note that we do not have a Victoreen nor a Nuclear Associates Model 64-773 or 773 instrument calibrator listed in our Registry of Approved Sources and Devices.
3. We have authorized you to possess phosphorus-32 and Group VI materials for storage only. In order to authorize your possession and use of these materials you will need to submit:
  - a. For phosphorus-32  
Submit the information specified in Item 1 above.
  - b. For Group VI  
Submit the following information:
    1. Specify where brachytherapy sources will be stored.
    2. Describe the equipment and shielding available for transporting the sources.

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3. Describe your source accountability system, periodic inventories, and leak test procedures for the brachytherapy sources. Also specify who will be the individual responsible for performing these duties.

Information submitted in response to this letter should state that it is additional information and not a new amendment request.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. You must conduct your program involving radioactive materials in accordance with the conditions of your NRC license, representations made in your license application, and NRC regulations. In particular, note that you must:

1. Operate in accordance with NRC regulations 10 CFR Part 19, "Notices, Instructions and Reports to Workers; Inspections," 10 CFR Part 20, "Standards for Protection Against Radiation," and other applicable regulations.
2. Possess radioactive material only in the quantity and form indicated in your license.
3. Use radioactive material only for the purpose(s) indicated in your license.
4. Notify NRC in writing of any change in mailing address.
5. Request and obtain appropriate amendment if you plan to change ownership of your organization, change locations of radioactive material, or make any other changes in your facility or program which are contrary to your license conditions or representations made in your license application and any supplemental correspondence with NRC. Any amendment request should be accompanied by the appropriate fee specified in 10 CFR Part 170.
6. Submit a complete renewal application with proper fee or termination request at least 30 days before the expiration date on your license. You will receive a reminder notice approximately 90 days before the expiration date. Possession of radioactive material after your license expires is a violation of NRC regulations.
7. Request termination of your license if you plan to permanently discontinue activities involving radioactive material prior to your expiration date.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions and representations in your license application will result in enforcement action against you in accordance with the General Policy and Procedures for NRC Enforcement Actions, 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C.
