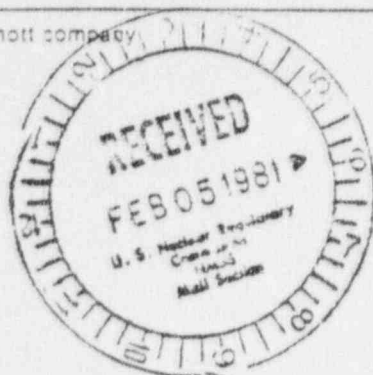

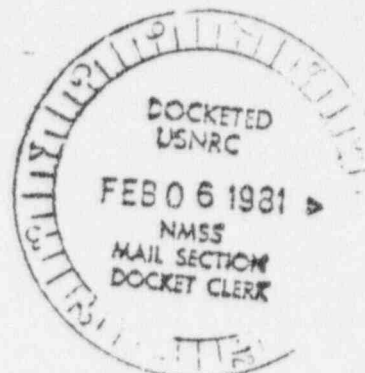

Dear Mr. McCorkle:

This is in response to your letter dated January 22, 1981 regarding revisions to the referenced plan. I have attached a submittal dated April 30, 1980 which, for reasons unknown to me, you did not receive. This should resolve this issue.

There is, however, a related issue that may or may not be a problem. In your latest letter you referenced a March 31, 1980 letter by which I submitted the referenced plan. My letter was dated March 17, 1980. My files indicate you transmitted questions regarding the March 17, 1980 submittal, by letter dated March 31, 1980. Although this is somewhat confusing, I think this situation will be resolved with the action you take regarding the attachment. My only concern is that six copies of the April 30, 1980 submittal may be lost and they contain information that should be withheld from the public. Please let me know if the missing submittal is located.
