In a letter dated August 1, 1968, you were advised of a proposed inspection of the AEC licensed program at Fort Richardson, Alaska, which was tentatively scheduled for late Tuesday morning, August 13, 1968. On August 6, 1968, Major G. L. Bower, USARAL Radiation Protection Officer, advised our office by telephone that the cognizant individuals associated with the licensed program had gone on leave and were not expected to return until approximately September 1, 1968. In view of the fact that the absence of individuals familiar with the licensed program would probably severely restrict the effectiveness of the inspection, we have decided to cancel our plans for an inspection at this time.

A representative of this office will be conducting inspections in Alaska during the summer of 1969, and an inspection of the subject AEC license would be conducted during that visit.

We wish to thank you for the courtesies shown by Major Bower's telephone call advising us that personnel associated with this licensed program were on leave.
