Dear Sir:

During the summer of 1968, we attempted to schedule a radiological health and safety inspection of the activities conducted at USARL Radioactive Material Disposal Facility at Fort Richardson as authorized by AEC license No. 50-10023-1. We were unable to conduct the inspection because the individuals familiar with the licensed program were all on leave during the period the AEC inspector was in Alaska.

We will conduct a series of inspections in Alaska during the summer of 1969, probably during July or August. Because of our failure to conduct the inspection in 1968, it is most important that we do so this summer.

Before I schedule this current inspection trip, I would appreciate it if you would inform me if there are any periods this summer when an inspection of the activities authorized by AEC license 50-10023-1 would not be practical. My main concern is availability of people at Fort Richardson who are familiar with the licensed program. Of course, we would inform you of specific dates for our visit when our schedule is firm.

Your cooperation in this matter is appreciated.
