Gentlemen:

Please refer to Byproduct Material License Number 50-10023-1, issued to Department of the Army, Headquarters, United States Army, Alaska (USARAL).

The USARAL Radioactive Material Disposal Facility located at Fort Richardson, Alaska was permanently closed on 3 December 1970. The disposal facility will no longer receive, store, or package radioactive waste from nuclear reactor facilities or from non-Army agencies. Such waste will be forwarded from the generating activities directly to licensed land burial sites. USARAL will provide administrative support to arrange for land burial instead of actually receiving such wastes. USARAL installations will package radioactive wastes resulting from material covered by AEC licenses issued to Army activities. The packaged waste will be forwarded to licensed land burial facilities for ultimate disposal. Consequently, license No. 50-10023-1 is no longer required.

We request that BML No. 50-10023-1 be cancelled.
