COMMENTS

During a telephone conversation of June 23, 1992, with Raymond Hall, Uranium Recovery Field Office, and Nina Pugh, Freedom of Information Act Office, it was confirmed that your request relates to the transfer of material from the Umetco Gas Hills mill (NRC Docket No. 40-0299) to the American Nuclear Corporation (ANC) mill (NRC Docket No. 40-4492). A review of the licenses for both facilities indicates that no such transfer of materials from Umetco Gas Hills mill to ANC has been requested or authorized. It has also been confirmed with personnel at the Umetco mill that they are not aware of any such transfer since their arrival at the mill in 1981.
