1989 ALL AGREEMENT STATES MEETING


This year, the State of Kansas will serve as the host State for the Annual All Agreement States Meeting to commemorate their 25th year in the Agreement States Program. The meeting will be held at the Overland Park Marriott Hotel, 10800 Metcalf, Overland Park, Kansas (913-451-8000).

Whoever is attending this meeting should call to confirm their room reservations from the block of rooms reserved at a rate of \$55.00 per night, plus 7.5% tax.

Whoever is attending this meeting, under NRC sponsorship, should call Dimensions Travel Company at 301-986-8949 and tell them: (1) your name, (2) the purpose of trip, and (3) ask that the tickets be mailed to you at your home address. Airline tickets obtained in any other manner will not be honored by the NRC for reimbursement. The per diem allotment for Overland Park, Kansas is \$60.00 for lodging, and \$26.00 for meals, for a total of \$86.00.
