(U) The NRC staff hereby submits supplementary classified views on one of the issues raised in connection with the subject pending license application:

(U) License No. XSNM-1222, as amended, to authorize Edlow International Company to export 16,803.6 kilograms of uranium, enriched to a maximum of 2.71%, to India for use in the Tarapur Atomic Power Station (TAPS).

(U) On December 8, 1978, the Commission ordered a public hearing focusing on four topics. The staff has provided comments on these four topics in a separate unclassified submission. The staff believes that additional comment, involving classified information, would be useful to the Commission in its consideration of the second topic to be addressed in these proceedings, i.e., the adequacy, for purposes of the C's determination under the NNPA, of the safeguards applied by the.

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
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
