
Representatives of Houston Lighting & Power Company (HL&P) met recently with Mr. Jack Whitten of NRC Region IV to discuss HL&P's application for a Type A License of Broad Scope. After reviewing the terms of the proposed license, HL&P requests that the following provisions be included:

The licensee may leak test sources and calibrate instruments for other groups, organizations, or companies, if done so in a manner as described in letters dated July 3, 1984, and January 18, 1985.

The licensee may dismantle devices manufactured under a general license if done so in accordance with the manufacturer's procedure and under specific approval of the Radiation Safety Committee of the South Texas Project Electric Generating Station.
