1. All documents(including videotapes, photos, etc.) on testing of nuclear spent fuel shipping casks, including but not limited to American and British tests.
2. All documents on the NRC's forthcoming Modal Study.
3. All documents (excluding those in the official docket of comments for the most recent proposed revision of safeguards regulations) related to the NRC prenotification of Governors Designees for spent fuel shipments.
4. All documents related to NRC and utility or carrier safeguards program for spent nuclear fuel shipments since latest version of NUREG-0561 went into effect: including but not limited to route designations, contacts with local law enforcement authorities, immobilization devices, escorts, enforcement, etc.

7. All documents related to development and/or certification of new spent fuel cask designs.
