Gentlemen:

We have received your invoice no. AMO-7707-91 in the amount of \$7800.00 for an annual fee for the above license. We have also received your invoice No. AMO 7706-91 in the amount of \$1700.00 for an annual fee for our QA shipping program. If you add to these amounts your yearly inspection fee and a prorated share of our license renewal costs we would have a yearly cost in excess of eleven thousand dollars. This amount could, and probably will be higher when you establish new rates for these items. If we were to realize our wildest dreams and make a ten percent profit, which we have never done on this type work, we would need to do over \$120,000 in radiographic work merely to pay your fees. It is not possible for us to do this.

We have not been doing any radiographic work in recent months. However, we wanted to maintain our license in hope that there would be an increase in this type of work in our area that would warrant our resuming the service. We have no iridium sources in our laboratory at this time. Attached are copies receiving reports covering the last two sources we returned. We have no plans, at this time, to resume doing any radiographic work
