Dear Dr. Adamov,

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter of October 2, 1992 and to assure you that it was provided to Chairman Selin. I received your correspondence and its attachments personally from Dr. Armand Lakner, and made sure that each of our Commissioners received a copy. We are considering your proposals and I will get back to you shortly on the possibility of U.S. involvement in RBMK safety assessments.

Even though we discussed it briefly, I am still unclear as to the magnitude of the void coefficient in the Ignalina reactor at various power levels. Could you enlighten me on any measurements or analyses? I understand there have been no major fuel enrichment changes in the core since the Chernobyl accident.
