

Dear Ms. Schapira:

This is in response to your letter dated March 30, 1981, addressed to the Department of Energy, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, copies of licenses and/or applications and renewals for Jersey Nuclear and related firms in connection with a fuel fabrication plant, handling of fissionable materials and a uranium mill located at Converse City, Wyoming.

The documents subject to your request can be found in Docket Files 40-8064, 40-8602 (mills); 70-1257, 70-2219 and 70-2324 (fuel fabrication). These documents have already been made available for public inspection and copying at the NRC Public Document Room (PDR), 1717 H Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20555. The charge for reproducing records located in the PDR is five cents (\$0.05) per page, as specified in 10 CFR 9.14(a). Copies of these documents can be purchased by writing directly to the PDR. Upon your agreement to pay the reproduction charges, the PDR will arrange for the records to be reproduced by Literature Research Company, a private reproduction contractor servicing the PDR. You will be billed by Literature Research Company for the reproduction charges, plus tax and postage.
