Dear Sir or Madam:

This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act as amended (5USC §552). I write to request a copy of the following:

a. An initial AEC license and/or application therefor by Jersey Nuclear during 1971 to operate a nuclear fuel fabrication plant and renewals thereof. I believe the relevant NRC docket number for the fuel fabrication plant is 70-1257 and that Jersey Nuclear or its successor, Exxon Nuclear Corporation, also obtained a license from the NRC, number SNM-1227 for the handling of fissionable materials at its fuel fabrication plant.

b. Other licenses and applications by related companies, specifically Jersey Nuclear-AVCO Industries, Inc; Exxon Nuclear; Exxon Nuclear, Inc.; Exxon Enterprises, Inc.; Jersey enterprises and similarly named organizations from 1970 to the present with any renewals, including but not limited to, such information under NRC docket number 40-8102 (and license number SUA-1139) relating to an Exxon uranium mill located at Converse City, Wyoming.

I believe such licenses, applications, and renewals may be part of the files of the AEC or the NRC, depending on the date.

The FOIA also provides that if only portions of a file are exempted, the remainder must be released. I therefore request that I be provided with all non-exempt portions which are reasonably segregable. Of course, I reserve the right to appeal any withholding of information; please advise me of the specific exemption which justifies your refusal to release information and my appeal procedures if records are withheld.

I am prepared to pay reasonable costs for locating the requested file and reproducing it. If the fees will


