
Dear Donnie Grimsley:

### FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST (92-039)

By copy of this letter, we are returning your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for response. Your letter requested, pursuant to the FOIA, responses to "survey questionnaires to 1,378 potential mixed waste generators, initiating Task 5 of the National Profile on Mixed Waste."

The NRC Weekly Information Report provided as an enclosure to your letter advised that Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL) is developing the National Profile for the NRC. Even though ORNL is operated for the Department of Energy (DOE) by its Management and Operating contractor, Martin Marietta Energy Systems, Inc. (Energy Systems), this particular work is being performed under a Work for Others agreement between Energy Systems and the NRC. The documents requested are not documents accessible pursuant to the FOIA through the DOE. Therefore, the NRC will respond directly to you concerning your request.
