This letter relates to the discussion Mr. Hyder of this office held with Colonel W. R. Morton, Lt. Colonel C. R. Wolff, and Captain B. H. Sheets, following the inspection conducted on March 11 and 12, 1968, of the activities authorized under AEC Byproduct Material License No. 30-03110-02 and Special Nuclear Material License No. SNM-597. As noted during the discussion, it appeared that certain of your activities were not conducted in full compliance with AEC requirements. The items and references to the pertinent requirements are listed in section 5 of the attached Forms AEC-592.

The purpose of this letter is to give you an opportunity to advise us in writing of your position concerning these items, of any corrective steps you have taken or plan to take with respect to them, and the date all corrective action was or will be completed. Your reply should be sent to us within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter to insure that it will receive proper attention in our further evaluation of the matter.
