Dear Mr. Abel:

On May 11, 1981, we issued Amendment Nos. 64 and 61 to Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-39 and DPR-48 for the Zion Station, Unit Nos. 1 and 2. These amendments revised the Technical Specification limits for total nuclear peaking factor for Zion Units 1 and 2 under base load and load follow modes of operation. In your application dated October 22, 1979, there were three pages of Technical Specifications to be changed. In your subsequent submittal on April 10, 1981, the Commonwealth Edison Company (CECo) included only two of the three pages. Our safety evaluation examined the need for accumulator volume changes and found them acceptable. Therefore, we have inadvertently omitted the enclosed Technical Specification from our May 11, 1981 license amendment. CECo should include this additional Technical Specification change in their current licenses.
