Dear Sir:

Pursuant to Part 9, 10 CFR, I am filing the following
Freedom of Information Act request.

2) I would like those documents listed on the attached
sheet.

This requester would also ask that the fees for the
production of the above-mentioned documents be waived
in accordance with the guidelines of 10 CFR sec. 9.14(a).

As enumerated in sub-paragraph (c):

1) Upon this requester's review and analysis of the
requested documents, it will be disseminated to other
members of the Mockingbird Alliance, a public interest
research group of which requester is a member. There
is a strong likelihood of this information being pub-
lished in the group's bi-monthly newsletter.

2) The size of that benefitting audience is about forty
regular members and at least 1200 more on the group's
mailing list.

3) This audience will receive the tangible benefit of
knowing more about the proposed nuclear plant near
Houston and about its nature, so that they might better
protect their interests.

4) Requester does not foresee any immediate financial
benefit (commercial or otherwise) from the use of the
requested documents.

5) As this group is a volunteer, "bootstrap" operation,
payment of these fees shall work a hardship upon it: the
group's resources are very limited.

6) The intended use of the records requested is likely to manifest in greater safety to Mockingbird Alliance members and to the Houston public in general. Once people are made aware of potential harms in the world around them, they are far more inclined to demand greater safety precautions.

ii) and iii) Requester expects no benefits to accrue in these categories.


iv) Information distilled and disseminated from the requested documents will definitely stoke the fire of debate currently raging in Houston, regarding the siting of Allens Creek Nuclear Power Station.

v) Requester expects no benefit here.

The weight of the above factors should clearly demonstrate that furnishing the documents and information contained therein can be considered as primarily benefiting the general public and that waiver of fees for search and production is proper.
