VIOLATION A.

- 1.) Dr. John Ojala of the University of Idaho in Idaho Falls was under the impression that the scientists at the U of I wanted the donation of the probes that Western Laboratories offered them but they had to go through several committees to determine the acceptance of radioactive materials making certain that those individuals were licensed to handle said material. We repeatedly contacted Dr. Ojala and we were told they were delaying and it still was not finalized that they could accept the probes.
- 2.) We have licensed them for storage only. They have been transported to the licensed storage site at Western Labs headquarters located at 211 Hwy. 95 Parma Idaho.
- 3.) They are on a five year storage license. We are still in the process of trying to legally dispose of them. We will only dispose of them to a licensed user. They will be swabbed before transport.
- 4.) Full compliance was met October 18, 1992.

VIOLATION B

- 1.) My son just lost his lease on his apartment and he had put them in what we thought was a safe environment until someone from Parma who was 300 miles away was able to bring them to the approved site.
- 2.) We had them brought to Parma and are in a licensed storage site located at Western Labs, 211 Hwy 95 Parma Idaho.
- 3.) We are trying to dispose of them in a lawful manner to a licensed user.
- 4.) Full compliance was met October 18, 1992.

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
