Dear Sir:

In accordance with the provisions of Reference 1, Dairyland Power Cooperative requests an exemption from the full amount of available on-site primary property damage insurance for the La Crosse Boiling Water Reactor (LACBWR) as set forth in 10 CFR 50.54 (w)(1) to a level of \$180 million and a continuation of the exemption from excess property insurance requirements as granted by NRR in a letter dated September 12, 1983.

This request is based on justifications presented in earlier correspondence with the Commission and on conclusions more recently derived in a technical report and its addendum of post-accident recovery costs of LACBWR. This recent information was forwarded to the Chief, Operating Reactor Branch No. 5 by letters dated February 7 and July 12, 1985.

Our February 7 letter discussed our intention to file an exemption request following a proposed meeting. The meeting took place on June 27.


A check for \$150 covering the fee for a license amendment application will be mailed in a few days.


