Dear Sir,

This letter is an application for renewal of our current NRC license (No. 48-00268-02). We wish to continue to operate under the conditions set forth in that license: Amendment #8, amended in its entirety (25 July 1979), and subsequently amended #9 (17 Oct 1980) and #10 (5 Dec 1983).

Our current program is described in the renewal application for our license, dated 26 May 1978, in the letter of 10 Sept 1980, referenced in amendment #9, and in the letters of 26 May 1978, 10 Aug 1983 and 24 Oct 1983, referenced in amendment #10. We will continue to operate, under the renewed license, in accordance with these documents, NRC regulations and the conditions set forth in our current license, as amended.

The following letters, referenced in our current license, are not applicable to the current program and could be dropped from the renewal license, if you deem it appropriate:

The letter dated 10 Oct 1978 (referenced in #8 and #10) is not relevant to the current license.

The letter dated 26 June 1979 (referenced in #8 and #10 also) was superceded by the letter of 10 Sept 1980 (referenced in #9).

After careful examination, all of the other documents referred to above were found to be up to date and applicable to our program. No changes in the program are planned at this time.

According to 10 CFR Part 170, Section 170.11(a4), no fees shall be required of a non-profit educational institution for a license to use byproduct and/or special nuclear material for teaching and training purposes, as requested in this application.


