Please refer to our application for Amendment to SUB-1010 dated December 8 and your request of February 26 that we secure State of Arkansas approval for use of this material. We have pursued this matter with the State of Arkansas and Ark-Kraft Corporation who are processing the appropriate permits.

However, we understand from Ark-Kraft Corporation that due to other problems of regulating the treatment system and the warm weather which had been experienced in this area during the winter that they will not need to add ammonium nitrate to their treatment ponds until the winter season begins on November 1976. Therefore, we withdraw the application for amendment to SUB-1010 described above.
