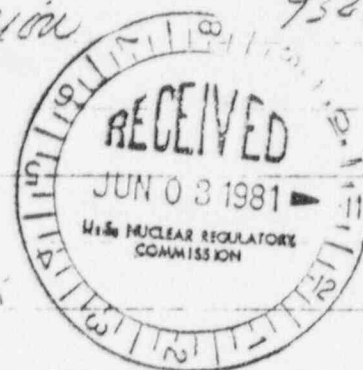

Dear Commission Chairperson:

Citizens who live within range of being contaminated by a failure in a nuclear power plant (such as a leaking of radioactive gas) must continue to have the right (as per the November 1980 U.S. Court of Appeals decision in the case of Sholly v. the NRC) to question the necessity of venting such gas.

At root, here, is the right of citizens to request public hearings in lieu of NRC decisions to vent, etc. Citizens must be allowed the right to defend themselves from possible ill health from radioactive substance. Consideration for human health must supercede a utilities desire to use a crippled power plant, for the purpose of gaining profits. Sincerely yours,
