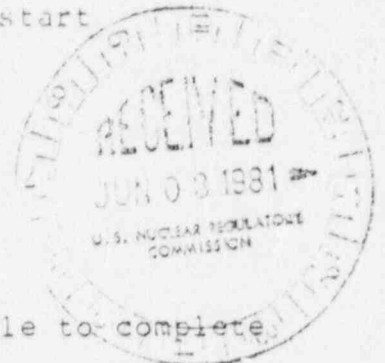


UNION OF CONCERNED SCIENTISTS

It has become apparent that UCS will be unable to complete its Proposed Findings by June 1. This is due primarily to the fact that at least 7 working days of the first 3 weeks of May have had to be devoted to preparing for and attending the last hearing session on the latest SER supplements.

A substantial portion of our Proposed Findings will be filed on June 1, covering at least UCS Contentions 1, 2, 3, 4 and 10. By this motion, UCS requests an extension of time until June 12 for the filing of the remainder of our Proposed Findings.
