Gentlemen:

Regarding your letters dated March 27, 1985 and April 19, 1985 requesting a corrected copy of Amendment No. 04 to License Number 18-02649-03, and our subsequent telephone discussions, the NRC has determined a corrected copy of Amendment No. 04 is not necessary.

The Region I Office has made contact with the State of Georgia, Sentrol Sensing Systems, Inc., and the NRC's Material Certification and Procedures Branch, Washington, D.C. and found that at one time the sources in the BG-I and BG-III gauges were mislabeled and in fact only contained 500 millicuries. Further those gauges are approved for distribution to general licensees. Therefore, you do not need to list these gauges on a specific license. Should you wish to list these generally licensed gauges on a specific license a fee would be charged. We have enclosed a copy of 10 CFR 31 which in section 31.5 describe the requirement for general licensees having gauging devices.


Thank you for your assistance in resolving the questions concerning the gauges.
