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Under Part III - CONTRACT SCHEDULE, the following changes are made:

A. Article II - Period of Performance is revised to read as follows:

"ARTICLE II - PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

The performance of work described in Article I hereof shall commence as of the effective date of this contract and shall continue to completion thereof, estimated to occur no later than September 30, 1981."

B. Article III - Consideration and Payment is revised to read as follows:

"ARTICLE III - CONSIDERATION AND PAYMENT

A. Estimated Cost, Fixed Fee and Obligation

1. It is estimated that the total cost to the Government for full performance of this contract will be \$136,665.00, of which the sum of \$128,929.00 represents the estimated reimbursable costs, and of which \$7,736.00 represents the fixed fee.
2. There shall be no adjustment in the amount of the contractor's fixed fee by reason of differences between any estimate of cost for performance of the work under this contract and the actual cost performance of that work.
3. The amount presently obligated by the Government with respect to this contract is \$136,665.00.

B. Payment
