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REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Our review of the revised Trojan Guard Training Plan submitted with the Portland General Electric Company letter dated April 30, 1981, indicated that some changes required by the January 23, 1981 NRC letter have not been made. The following information must be added to the plan:

- ° Commit to weapon and site ammunition requirements of Appendix B.V.A.4. This information is not found in Table 1-2 of the security plan as claimed.
- ° Commit to the use of two-way portable radios, 2 channels minimum, one operating and one emergency as required by Appendix B.V.10. Two one channel radios are not a satisfactory substitute.

In addition, specific crucial task information identified in NUREG-0674 which was submitted previously and found acceptable has now been deleted from the standards column in the Job Analysis Work Sheets. The reference to replacement of Safeguards Contingency Procedures is not acceptable. Since this is a training document, the information in the Guard Training Plan must be presented in a manner that is measurable and observable. It is recommended that the functions identified in NUREG - 0674 be restored to the wording used in the original plan.
