Gentlemen:

Please find enclosed an amendment to your NRC Material License.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the Region I Material Licensing Section, (215) 337-5093, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please be advised that you must conduct your program involving licensed radioactive materials in accordance with the conditions of your NRC license, representations made in your license application, and NRC regulations. In particular, please note the items in the enclosed, "Requirements for Materials Licensees."

Please note that Joel S. Schuman, M.D., is not listed as an authorized user of radioactive material, although he has attended training for the safe use of licensed material. He should apply for approval at a future date after he has gained experience in the receipt, use, and disposal of radioactive material and in performing surveys for contamination under the supervision of an authorized user.

Also, please note that License Conditions 16 and 17 are no longer listed. Your letter dated December 6, 1988 establishes your required action limits for decontamination, and 10 CFR 20.401 requires that records of surveys be maintained.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, the NRC expects licensees to pay meticulous attention to detail and to achieve the high standard of compliance which the NRC expects of its licensees.

We wish you success in operating a safe and effective licensed program.
