Gentlemen:

Please find enclosed an amendment to your NRC Material License.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the Region I Material Licensing Section, (215) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please be advised that you must conduct your program involving licensed radioactive materials in accordance with the conditions of your NRC license, representations made in your license application, and NRC regulations. In particular, please note the items in the enclosed, "Requirements for Materials Licensees."

Prior to release of your old facility for unrestricted use you should be sure that the facilities meet the criteria in the enclosed "Guidelines for Decontamination of Facilities and Equipment Prior to Release for Unrestricted Use or Termination of Licenses for Byproduct Source, or Special Nuclear Material". You should submit a report of the results of the surveys you performed to this office and refer to this letter.

In order not to delay the replacement of your committee chairman, the exchange frequency in your personnel dosimetry program and the increased possession limits for life science research we have amended your license for those portions of your March 1, 1985 request. However, in accordance with our telephone conversation May 17, 1985 we will not act on your requests concerning the Radioisotopes Committee membership or the deletion of two locations of use from your license until we receive the additional information requested and the necessary closeout surveys. We cannot act to add the Stine Green house location to your license since this location is a place of use under E. I. du Pont Stine Haskell Laboratories license.
