SUBJECT: ACTIONS IN REPSONSE TO TROPICAL STORM "BOB" - UPDATE

This PN updates PNO-II-85-70 and PNO-II-85-70A, issued on July 23 and July 24, 1985.

Region II has terminated its monitoring of tropical storm "Bob," based on the storm's current status and the fact that there have been no reports of damages involving NRC-licensed activities in the storm area. During the storm watch, Region II was in contact by NRC high-frequency radio with three Region II staff members who were at Brunswick performing a routine inspection.

Although the National Weather Service upgraded "Bob" to hurricane status at 6 p.m. (EDT) July 25, it was downgraded to a tropical depression as of 6 a.m. yesterday. By late yesterday, the depression had moved to a position off the coast of Virginia, and its internal winds had dissipated to about 25 knots. The National Weather Service is no longer issuing special reports on it.
