
Thank you for your letter dated July 1, 1985, informing us of the steps you have taken to correct the noncompliance which we brought to your attention in our letter dated June 17, 1985. We will examine these matters during a future inspection.

The information provided in your letter was not made available to our inspector during his visit to your facility on June 5 and 7, 1985. You should ensure that in the future, the persons responsible for routine operation of your licensed program are familiar with the location and content of your records of personnel audits and inspections, radiographic equipment inspection and maintenance, and quarterly inventories, all required by 10 CFR 34.26, 34.28(b) and License Condition No. 16.

We will adjust our records to reflect that no violation of regulatory requirements occurred with respect to items 1, 2, and 3 contained in our Notice of Violation dated June 17, 1985.


