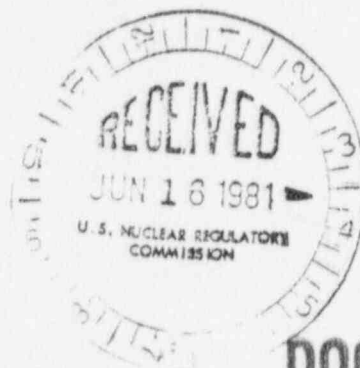
Dear Sirs,

Regarding the Nuclear Reactor Plants in California, around the Los Angeles area, I am concerned about the safety and efficiency of the Diablo Reactor Site. The location is well isolated from any well established communities, but an accident of any large magnitude due to damage from an earthquake or other natural happening may cause serious environmental withdrawals of the land. After reading the Environmental Impact Report, it shows that there may be a decrease in marine life around the intake and cooling system area. Steps should be taken to move or ballance out the number of species in these locations.

Disposal of the radio active waste seems to raise many unhappy feelings toward the efficeint operation of the reactors. A number of sealed containers which hold the waste products have been found to leak or deteriorate. This is not a good solution for the eternal problem of disposal, by answering the crisis with a terminal outcome.
