## ENCLOSURE

### COMMENTS ON CALLAWAY GUARD TRAINING PLAN Docket No. STN 50-403

Our review of the plan indicates that it requires only a limited number of revisions to be acceptable.

#### Specific Comments

- 1.1 Revise the first sentence to read, "Union Electric Company confirms that every member of the station security force shall meet all of the requirements for the suitability criteria of 10 CFR 73 Appendix B, relative to minimum age, educational development and felony convictions".
- 1.2 Expand the physical fitness testing program for the security force members to include other strenuous activities in addition to the running requirement.
- 1.5 Revise the first paragraph to read, "Union Electric Company confirms that all Callaway Security force personnel will be tested at least once every 12 months to insure they meet all of the requirements for the vision, hearing, license, addiction and other physical requirements of paragraph 1.D and 1.E 10 CFR 73 Appendix B".

#### Additional Information

Within Section 1 of the plan, commit to the requirements of the following sections of Appendix B; B.I.E, B.II.A, B&C, and B.II.E.

Within Section 2 of the plan, commit to the requirements of Appendix B.V.A.5 including a description of the portable radios.

Provide rationale for indicating that the CAS/SAS operators are weapons trained (task 12 and 13), but the Badge Control Officer, Search Control Officer and Vehicle Control Escort are not so trained and qualified.

#### Task 1

Commit to having the CAS/SAS operators use CCTV to identify potential intruders and obtain data on adversary actions.
