Dear Senator Bradley:

Two large power stations are ready to generate electricity and replace foreign oil but they are just sitting out there. Three thousand megawatts of capacity idle when domestic energy is needed. This story is almost unbelievable.

I urge you to take action to see that the undamaged unit at Three Mile Island and the two unit plants at Diablo Canyon California receive permits from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission so that they might begin generating power and save some 30 million barrels of foreign oil a year.
