This refers to your letter dated May 22, 1991, for renewal of Materials License 20-00289-10.



We direct your attention to the enclosed Federal Register notice dated July 10, 1991, regarding revisions to the Commission's fee regulations (10 CFR 170 and CFR 171), which became effective August 9, 1991. Applications for licensing actions postmarked on or after the effective date are subject to the revised fees in 10 CFR 170. Additionally, materials licensees are subject to the newly established materials license annual fees in 10 CFR 171.
