SUBJECT: SEQUOYAH FUELS CORPORATION (SFC) ENVIRONMENTAL FINDINGS

We have reviewed your June 10, 1991, memorandum regarding the inspector's recommendations for potential licensing action. With the exception of the combination stream sediment, the items have been discussed in meetings between regional and headquarters staff and in the quarterly meetings with Sequoyah Fuels Corporation (SFC). The issue of the combination stream sediment dealt with precipitation of the uranium from the low-flow stream. SFC addressed this issue by installing the pipeline. The other items will be considered in our review of SFC's environmental investigation findings and the license renewal.
