Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated December 2, 1963, which amended your application for a license to use byproduct material for industrial radiography.

The information in the application as revised by your December 2 letter appears to be adequate with one exception, which is the training of radiographic personnel. The extent of the training given to radiographic personnel is not clear from the information contained in the application and the other license files referenced in Item 2 of your application, Form AEC-313R. Your application indicates personnel will receive an one-hour indoctrination course prior to working with radiographic sources. It further indicates they will receive on-the-job training from senior radiographers and are not permitted to use sources by themselves until they also complete the formal training program as indicated in the attachments. No particular attachment is identified as a training program, nor is there any indication of the time to be devoted to the formal training program or the depth or scope of instruction given during this period of instruction. Upon receipt of a description of an adequate program for training radiographic personnel, we are prepared to issue the license.
