

APPENDIX A

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of the inspection conducted on December 2, 1992, and in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions," 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C (Enforcement Policy) (1992), the following violation was identified:

10 CFR 35.13 states, in part, that a licensee must apply and receive a license amendment before it permits anyone to work as an authorized user under the license.

Contrary to the above, as of September 1991, the licensee did not apply for and receive a license amendment prior to permitting two doctors to work as authorized users. Specifically, work was performed by two unauthorized users for over a year who were not listed on the license and did not meet the requirements for visiting authorized users.

This is a Severity Level IV violation. (Supplement VI)

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, the Carlisle Hospital is hereby required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of the letter which transmitted this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending this response time.
