
Dear Administrative Judges:

We are filing today Applicants' Motion for Summary Disposition of Joint Intervenors' Contention 10.5 (ASCO Solenoid Valves), Applicants' Statement of Material Facts as to Which No Genuine Issue Exists to Be Heard Regarding Contention 10.5 (ASCO Solenoid Valves), Affidavit of Richard B. Miller, and Affidavit of Victor L. Gonzales. Copies of the above are enclosed.

Also enclosed is a copy of WCAP-8687 Supp. 2-H02A/H05A Addendum 1 Revision 0, which is entitled "Equipment Qualification Test Report, ASCO Solenoid Valve Qualification to a Derated Westinghouse Generic LOCA/MSLB Profile." This report, which

is discussed in the affidavits of Richard B. Miller and Victor Gonzales, contains information proprietary to Westinghouse Electric Corp. When formally transmitted to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission on April 8, 1985, the report was accompanied by an application for withholding proprietary information from public disclosure in accordance with the provisions of 10 C.F.R. § 2.790 of the Commission's regulations. The NRC has honored Westinghouse's request and has not made the report available to the public, and the Applicants request that the members of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board treat the report in a like manner. The Applicants are providing copies of the report only to the members of the Board, counsel for the NRC staff, and to those representatives of the Joint Intervenors that have entered into a nondisclosure agreement with Westinghouse.
