Please expedite processing of the subject export license.


It is a Yugoslav edicted business practice that there be a contingent of nuclear fuel on site at all times, a practice that is certainly understandable.

The fuel assemblies scheduled for shipment in June are the contingent needed for 1985. The fuel already stored on site in 1984 will be used in the June 1985 refueling.

We must commit this shipment to a June 23 sailing out of Norfolk since the next vessel that would satisfy the shipping requirements would arrive in Yugoslavia in August which is a vacation month in Yugoslavia. We need early notification of license approval for preparation and domestic shipping.

Your assistance will be much appreciated.
