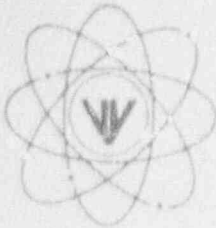

Subject: 1993 Vermont Yankee Emergency Exercise

Dear Sir:

This letter is to serve as formal notification of a change in the date for the 1993 Vermont Yankee Emergency Preparedness Exercise. The Exercise date has been changed from the week beginning Sunday, April 18, 1993 [as provided in Reference (b)] to the week beginning Sunday, April 25, 1993. The States of Vermont and New Hampshire, The Commonwealth of Massachusetts, FEMA, NRC and Vermont Yankee have all verbally consented to this date change.

Vermont Yankee still intends to submit the exercise scenario to NRC on or about January 18, 1993, well in advance of the recommended NRC submittal schedule. This will allow additional time for NRC review of the submitted material.
