Because of the lack of sufficient time for the solicitation, receipt, and approval of the above proposal, an exception to Manual Chapter 1102 is requested in order to permit Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory (LLNL) personnel to attend the January 18-20, 1984 Electric Power Research Institute (EPRI) workshop at Washington, D.C. Approval for the funding of \$11,000 (0.08 psy for FY-1984) enabling LLNL personnel to attend the above EPRI-sponsored workshop is requested. Participation of LLNL personnel, along with industry, U. S. Geological Survey, and NRC representatives, at the workshop is essential for an orderly, timely exchange of information regarding the progress of the NRC and utility-sponsored seismic hazard programs.
